



MOUNT RILEY PINOT NOIR 2010

WINEMAKERS NOTES:

The grapes that went into this wine were sourced from Marlborough and Nelson. Cool spring weather during flowering resulted in moderate crop levels and meant the fruit we harvested had impressive depth of flavour and weight. Harvest was a little later than usual but warm weather through March and April meant we were able to fully ripen grapes and resulted in ripe flavours and tannins. Grapes were cold soaked, fermented in small parcels and aged for nine months in French barriques.

TASTING NOTES:

<i>Colour</i>	Mid-red with garnet and ruby hues.
<i>Bouquet</i>	Dark cherry and red berry fruit aromas are supported by hints of spice and earthiness.
<i>Palate</i>	An approachable, elegant wine with soft tannins, delicious ripe red fruit flavours and great concentration.
<i>Drink</i>	Drinking well now and up to 2015. Great as an aperitif or with chicken, salmon, game, red meat and pasta.
