



MOUNT RILEY PINOT NOIR 2005

WINEMAKERS NOTES:

The Pinot Noir grapes for this wine were sourced from Marlborough (including our premium Seventeen Valley vineyard). A spectrum of clones (including UCD 5 and 6, 10/5 and Dijon clones 115, 118, 375 and 777) were used to add complexity. The wine was fermented on skins and aged for seven months in new and 1 year old barriques. .

TASTING NOTES:

- Colour* Vibrant mid-red with purple/violet hues.
- Bouquet* Enticing blackcurrant, plum & violet characters, supported by spicy white pepper & savoury notes.
- Palate* A supple wine with concentrated, fresh fruit flavours, fine tannins and a clean crisp finish.
- Drink* Drinking well now, this wine will continue to drink well up to 2010. Great as an aperitif or with chicken, game, red meat & pasta.
