



MOUNT RILEY PINOT NOIR 2011

WINEMAKERS NOTES:

The grapes that went into this wine were sourced from multiple vineyard sites throughout the Wairau Valley in Marlborough. Multiple vineyard parcels and clonal material means we can make a complex and complete wine with great fruit character and depth of flavour. Grapes were cold soaked, fermented in small parcels and aged for nine months in French barriques.

TASTING NOTES:

<i>Colour</i>	Mid-red with garnet and ruby hues.
<i>Bouquet</i>	Red cherry and berry fruit aromas are supported by hints of spice and earthiness.
<i>Palate</i>	An approachable, elegant wine with soft tannins, delicious bright red fruit flavours and great length of flavour.
<i>Drink</i>	Drinking well now and up to 2016. Great as an aperitif or with chicken, salmon, game, red meat and pasta.
